BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE



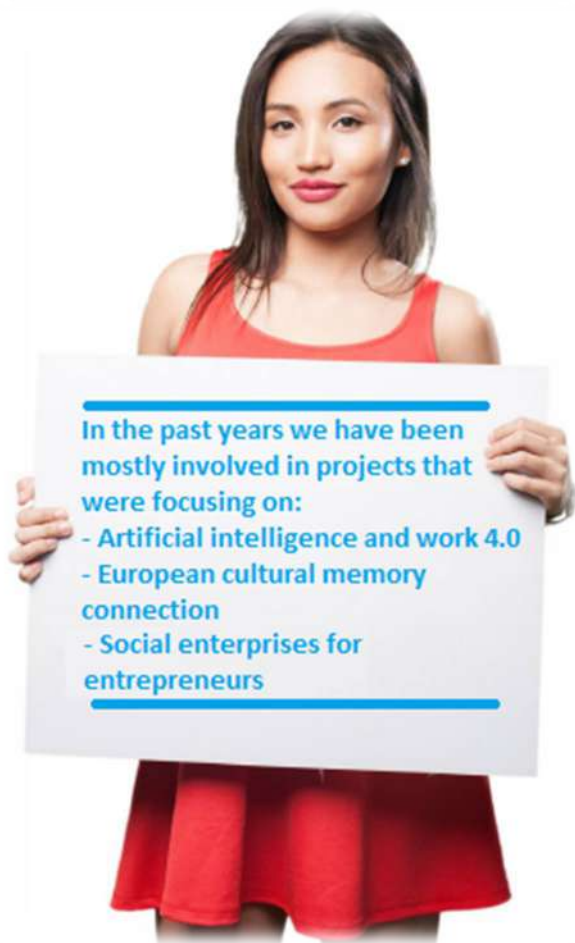
Short description of the organization

All of them have carried out projects with the youth. Right now we are working on a Social Enterprise project to help the disadvantaged have a foothold in entering the labor market.

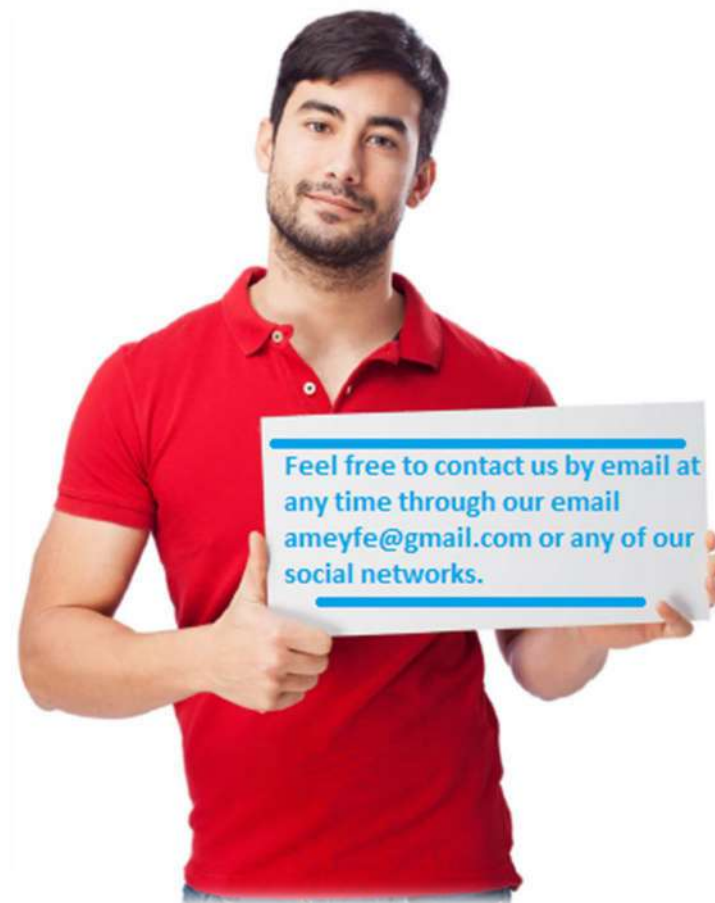
